Transport Options

Our Flight Coordinators will explain the following travel options to help determine the most appropriate method of transport.



- Air Ambulances are fully equipped planes with comprehensive state-of-the-art life support equipment to meet the critical care needs of those who fly with us.
- Commercial Air Escort Service is an appropriate alternative when the patient is capable of sitting in a First Class seat of a commercial airline during take-off and landing, needs limited oxygen and is not in need of critical care. The patient is escorted by a nurse or paramedic.





• Medical Escort via Amtrak. The patient is accompanied by a nurse or paramedic in a sleeper car of an Amtrak train, and receives assistance with medications, meals, hygiene, mobility and other care issues.



- International Commercial Airline Stretcher Service is an option when someone becomes ill or injured abroad. Flight Coordinators manage all aspects of the medical flight, including communication between sending and receiving physicians, ticketing, obtaining visas if necessary, arranging for ground transportation and clearing the transport with government agencies.
- Long Distance Ground Transportation is especially appropriate when relocating patients across state lines, from one facility to another or to a patient's home, within a distance that would not be practical for air transport.

Pricing Considerations

It is our goal at U.S. Air Ambulance to provide the highest quality service at the lowest possible cost.

Price is determined based primarily upon the medical condition of the patient, because this will determine the type of aircraft or ground transportation, medical supplies and team, the length of the trip and the urgency of travel.
